Various festivals are being celebrated at orphanage to create a feeling of domestic atmosphere for orphans in Ghugal Wadgaon, Shrigonda.

N-95 masks are collected from NGO and under the guidance of medical professionals, they are being supplied to the people who are poor and needy in various villages of Shrigonda.
